

ValveLink™ Mobile Software and *Easy Upgrade* on the 375 and 475 Field Communicators

Because the ValveLink™ Mobile software application on the 375 and 475 Field Communicators is part of the system software provided in these units, it has a slightly different behavior with *Easy Upgrade* than normal Device Descriptions (DD) do. Beginning with version 3.3 of the 375 and 475 Field Communicators' system software, here is how this relationship works:

- 1) If a 375 Field Communicator has an *Easy Upgrade* license that has expired prior to December 10, 2009, ValveLink Mobile software will **NOT** run when upgraded to version 3.3. If *Easy Upgrade* is subsequently renewed, ValveLink Mobile software will then run on that unit.
- 2) If a 375 Field Communicator has an *Easy Upgrade* license that is still current or has expired after December 10, 2009, ValveLink Mobile software **WILL** run on that unit when it is upgraded to version 3.3.
- 3) If a 475 Field Communicator was purchased with an *Easy Upgrade* license, ValveLink Mobile software **WILL** run on that unit.
- 4) If a 475 Field Communicator was purchased without an *Easy Upgrade* license, ValveLink Mobile software will **NOT** run on that unit. If *Easy Upgrade* is subsequently licensed on this unit, ValveLink Mobile software will then run on that unit.
- 5) If conditions #2 and #3 above are met, the 375 and 475 Field Communicators **WILL** accept all future upgrades to ValveLink Mobile software even after *Easy Upgrade* expires.
