



IECEX QUALITY ASSESSMENT AGREEMENT

pursuant to the IEC Scheme for Certification to Standards for Electrical Equipment for Explosive Atmospheres (IECEX Scheme) – IECEX 02: Rules of Procedure

Parties:

KEMA Quality B.V., a Netherlands limited liability company, having its registered office in Arnhem, the Netherlands, hereinafter referred to as "**KEMA**",

and

Emerson Process Management, Valve Automation Division, having its registered office in Hengelo, The Netherlands, hereinafter referred to as "**Emerson Hengelo**"

Whereas:

- Emerson Hengelo is a manufacturer of equipment and/or components ("products") as specified in the Certificate of Conformity to this agreement, and
- Emerson Hengelo applies a Quality System for production, final equipment inspection and testing of the products concerned, as specified in the aforesaid certificate, and has lodged an application for assessment in accordance with IECEX 02, and
- KEMA, in its capacity of Certification Body appointed by the IECEX Management Committee of the IECEX Scheme, has assessed the quality system of Emerson Hengelo, to determine its conformity to the requirements in aforesaid Scheme, and
- KEMA has established that the quality system implemented by Emerson Hengelo satisfies the requirements referred to in IECEX 02 and has notified Emerson Hengelo of its conclusions regarding the examination and the reasons for its decision,

Have agreed as follows:

- 1 KEMA hereby grants to Emerson Hengelo the right to carry the enclosed Quality Assessment Report under the terms and conditions hereof for the following production site:

- 2 The equipment and/or components of Emerson Hengelo governed by the aforesaid Quality Assessment Report (QAR) may not be placed on the market unless a valid IECEx Certificate of Conformity for the equipment and/or components is in place.
- 3 This agreement shall be governed by the provisions of the General Terms and Conditions for the Performance of Assessment and Certification Services.
- 4 This agreement will be entered into for the period of three (3) years, and may be extended repeatedly for not more than three (3) years at a time, on application filed by Emerson Hengelo not later than three (3) months before the expiration of the aforesaid period of time or its extension. After receipt of such application, KEMA shall carry out a re-assessment, at its then current rates and other terms and conditions. Surveillance audits are part of this agreement.
- 5 This agreement shall be effective as of the date of issuance of the Quality Assessment Report.
