Warning: This product has specific instructions for installation, removal and operation in hazardous areas. Refer to document 12P5403 "*DeltaV™ Electronic Marshalling Digital Automation System (CHARM I/O Subsystem) Zone 2 Installation Instructions*". Other installation instructions are available in the "*DeltaV™ S-series and CHARMS Hardware Installation*" manual.

Removal and Insertion

CHARMS can be inserted or removed under power only when the maximum power supplied to the CHARM I/O card (KL2101X1-BA1) has an open circuit voltage (Voc) of 26.4 VDC. DeltaV bulk power supplies (KJ1502X1) meet this voltage requirement when installed according to the installation instructions.

An I/O loop assessment must be completed on all energy-limited nodes.

A keying system ensures compatibility between a CHARM and the CHARM terminal block when the CHARM is installed on the terminal block. The terminal block keys are automatically set the first time the CHARM is installed on the terminal block. To install another CHARM type on a terminal block, reset the keys by removing the terminal block and releasing the keys from the locked position.

Maintenance and Adjustment

This unit contains no user serviceable parts and should not be disassembled for any reason. Calibration is not required.
