LiDestri now plans to conduct similar walkdowns at its four other plants and integrate MyAssets into their operations as well.

With five manufacturing facilities across the US, LiDestri is a premier private label and contract manufacturer of food, beverages, and spirits. Every year, the company supplies over 40 million cases of oils, salsas, pasta sauces, finishing sauces, dips, condiments, and other foods. At its Fairport, NY location, the company offers production capabilities that include hot fill and retort, organic-CCOF, USDA Organic Certified, Certified for USDA Beef and Poultry, and Certified for Kosher Foods (OU).

CHALLENGE

Manual filing systems were inefficient and costly

LiDestri is challenged by harsh conditions and complex troubleshooting. Its outdated technology systems made it difficult to manage their device inventory. As a result, asset management and device maintenance have been reactive and inefficient. If a process had to be shut down to troubleshoot a device, it would cost the company \$3,500 every hour.

SOLUTION

A digital revolution in maintenance and repairs

Emerson assisted LiDestri by providing walkdown services supported by MyAssets, part of the MyEmerson suite of productivity tools. During the walkdown, asset locations, tags, and device status, configuration, and condition were recorded in MyAssets, including Emerson flow devices, key non-Emerson devices on the floor, and even decommissioned equipment and devices in the storeroom. This enabled a detailed evaluation and analysis of LiDestri's assets. Key findings revealed that of the 48 devices surveyed— measurement instruments, valves, actuators, and regulators—40% needed maintenance and 1% were retired or obsolete.
